



Coronavirus jab: will there be side effects?

Side effects

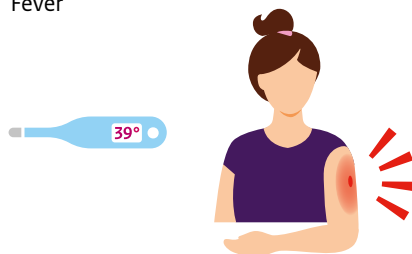
Some people have no issues after getting their jab. But others might get a sore arm after the injection, or have muscle pain or fever for a few days. These are called 'side effects'.



What are the possible side effects?

You might have the following side effects:

- Pain where you had the injection
- A headache
- Feeling tired
- Muscle pain
- Fever



Painkillers

The side effects above will normally last between 1 and 3 days. You can take painkillers if you need to. You might have other side effects but the chance is very small. If you experience a lot of side effects or are in a lot of pain, call your doctor immediately.
